1 Who are Avara Foods?

2 What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a real job where Apprentices learn, gain experience and get paid. By the end of an apprenticeship, apprentices will have the right skills and knowledge needed for their chosen career.

Each apprenticeship has a level and an equivalent education level. You can start an apprenticeship at any level. It can take between one and six years to complete an apprenticeship depending on each course, what level it is and your previous experience. It's fully funded by the employer and all apprentices come out with nationally or internationally recognised qualifications.

3 What is a Degree Apprenticeship?

University is not the only route to success! Apprentices gain a widely recognised and valued degree, whilst gaining hands on industry experience - without the debt of university. In fact, apprentices completing a higher apprenticeship could earn £150,000 more, on average, over their lifetime

4 What are the benefits of an apprenticeship?

All apprentices will:

- Learn and train for a specific job
- Get paid & have their study funded
- Get hands-on experience in a real job
- Study for at least 20% of their working hours – usually at college, university or with a training provider
- Complete assessments during and at the end of the apprenticeship
- Be on a career path with lots of future opportunities



5 Why an Avara Apprenticeship and what's on offer?

At Avara Foods, we offer intermediate, advanced and degree apprenticeships from Level 2 to Level 6, across a range of subjects taking between one and five years to complete depending on your course. Typical Roles are available in functions such as Engineering, Technical and Operations.

6 Degree Apprenticeships at Avara Foods

Our Degree Apprenticeships are level 6 qualifications in Food Science or Food Technology, which run in partnership with Harper Adams University. These Apprenticeships combine academic based learning with hands-on experience and training where apprentices have a full time role working within our teams at our operational sites.

With salaries beginning at £19,000 and steadily rising each year, our Apprentices come out with a degree at the end of it, five years work experience and a permanent job, all without any student debt!
